



Energy Services Two Open Positions for **UTILITIES ENGINEER** Civil and Mechanical

Energy Services – a Facilities Management department at Oklahoma State University’s Stillwater campus invites qualified individuals to apply for one of two full-time, hands-on, dynamic **Utilities Engineer** (UE) positions.

Both UE positions’ primary responsibility is development and maintenance of the campus models for chilled water, hot water, and steam (MECHANICAL) and domestic water, storm sewer, and sanitary sewer (CIVIL). The ideal candidates will have Civil or Mechanical expertise, experience with modeling software, system designs and reviews, and an understanding of professional project management. Applicants must possess strong analytical skills and the ability to pay meticulous attention to detail.

These UE positions complement existing departmental strengths in electrical, mechanical, and civil engineering as well as utilities production, distribution, and energy systems management. The UE is an active participant in the department’s culture of collaboration and cross-organization support - the foundation for Energy Services’ successful delivery of its mission.

A BS in Engineering is required, with an existing EIT, FE, or endorsement from a current PE. Each position offers opportunities and support for development toward professional engineering certification. Existing PEs are encouraged to apply.

Energy Services is a progressive department in the Facilities Management group and supports on-going professional development of all Energy Services staff.
