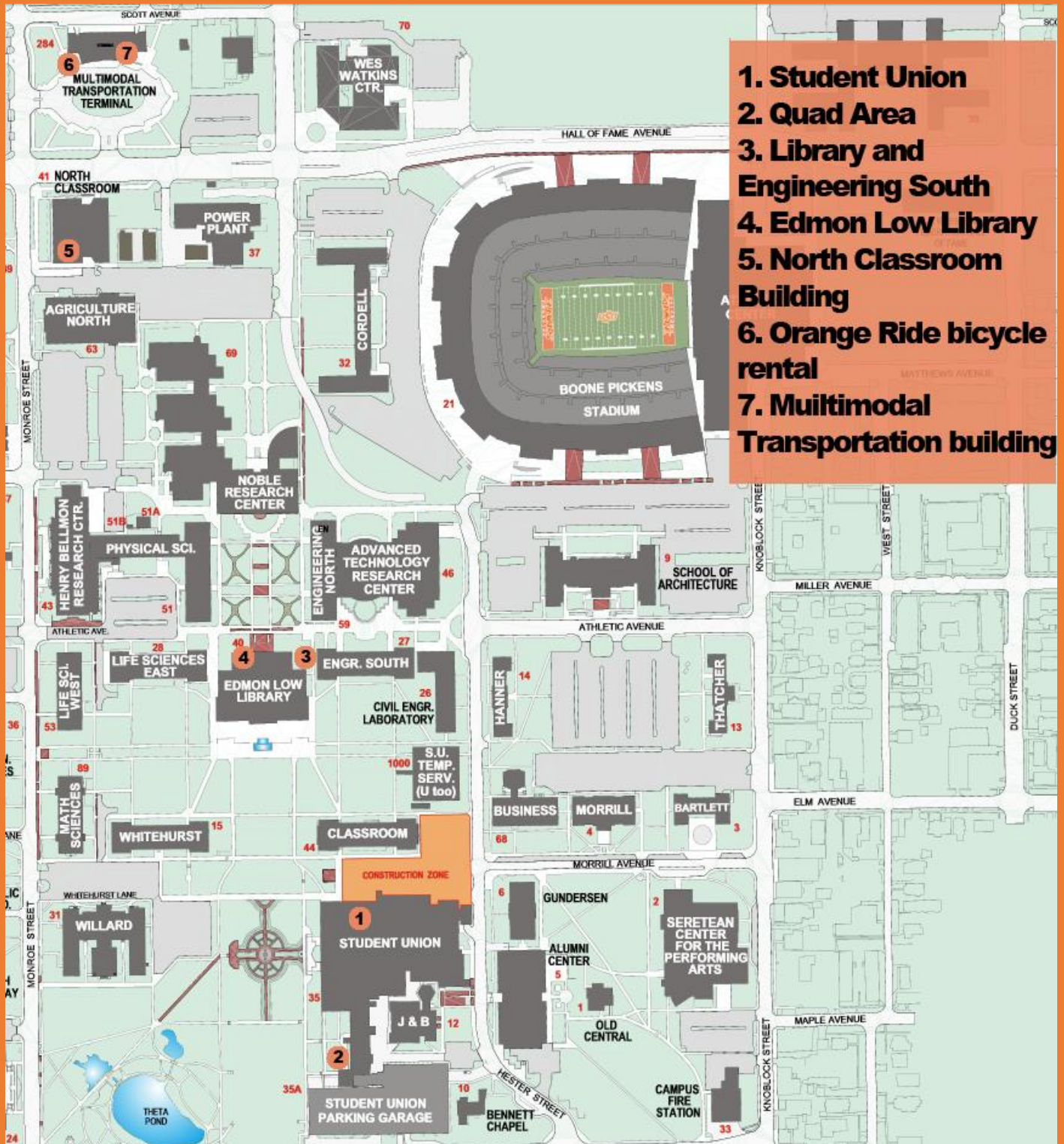


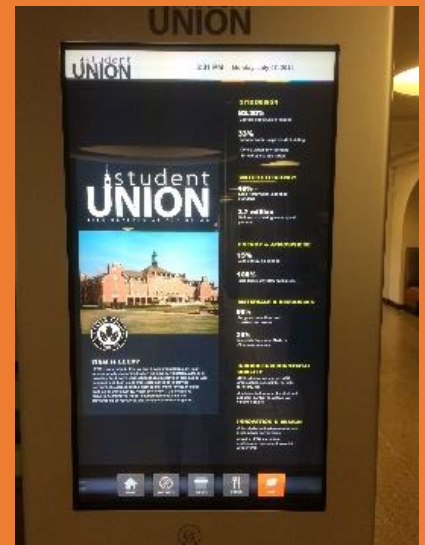
OSU Sustainability Walking Tour

1. Student Union

- A LEED Kiosk and touch screen in the western entrance of the Student Union helps students, workers, and visitors manage their way around the Student Union.
- Red Earth Kitchen located on the first floor serves locally sourced food.
- In front of Red Earth Kitchen, is a bar height counter made of sunflower seed shells for students, workers, or visitors to eat or hang out at.
- At the entrance of Union Express, the convenience store inside the Student Union, is a counter is made from recycled HDPE.
- While in the convenience store you can also purchase Dining Services' Cups for a Cause that you can reuse to fill up your favorite fountain drink at a discount.
- To help keep OSU America's Brightest Orange there are easy to see recycle bins located throughout the Student Union.



2. Quad Area

- Located on some of the trees and shrubs is a QR code that when scanned shows information about trees and shrubs on OSU's campus. OSU is a Tree Campus USA.
- Located outside the Ranchers Club, on the west side of the Student Union is what OSU calls the Mother's Garden. The Mother's Garden is home to beautiful flowers and herbs for the Ranchers Club restaurant.
- Next to the Mother's Garden is a rainwater collection system that allows OSU to save potable water by reusing rainwater when possible.
- OSU has recycle bins around the quad area to help keep campus looking beautiful for everyone to enjoy.

3. Between library and Engineering South

- OSU has placed an air pump and tools between Edmon Low Library and Engineering South so that students, workers, or visitors can fill up their bicycle tires or make minor repairs when riding around campus.



4. Edmon Low Library

- Inside the library, on the first floor west entrance near the elevator is one of OSU's many water bottle refilling stations. Water bottle refill station encourage the reuse of water bottles rather than having them go to the landfill.



5. North Classroom Building

- Roots Café, an eco-friendly eatery, on the first floor of the North Classroom Building, features a selection of organic foods, Fair Trade coffee, and eco-friendly cups and other products to help students, workers, and visitors eat more sustainably.

6. Orange Ride bike rental

- Next to the bus station, is Orange Ride bicycle rental and repair shop, a bike shop for anyone including non-students to rent a bike or have one repaired.



7. Multimodal Transportation building

- OSU has a CNG (compressed natural gas) bus fleet to help students and Stillwater residents get to and from campus or around campus
